Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), as amended; and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 2004"), as amended, and all other enabling powers; and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

The County of Somerset Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Unloading and On-street Parking Taunton Deane Order 2012 shall be amended by the revocation of the Map Schedule specified in the First Schedule to this Order and the insertion of the Map Schedule specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.

The provisions of the following Orders are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this order.

1. Summary

Proposals for changes to parking and waiting restrictions at 12 locations within Taunton Deane were advertised on the 31st January 2019. The proposed Traffic Regulation Order and Notice are shown in Appendix 1. A copy of the plan of the proposed parking restrictions is shown in Appendix 2.

Objections were received for 5 locations as follows:

Church Road, Trull. 6 objections were received. A decision has been agreed with Trull Parish Council not to implement the proposal at this time but to consider it again under the Taunton Parking Review.

Trendle Road/ Newbarn Park Road, Comeytrove. 41 objections were received. SCC will not go ahead with this proposal at this time but will consider it again under the Taunton Parking Review.

Avon Close, Comeytrove. 1 objection received. Please see below for this proposal to be determined.

Gaunton Close, Comeytrove. 1 objection received. Please see below for this proposal to be determined.

Collett Road, Norton Fitzwarren. 5 objections received. Please see below for this proposal to be determined.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 It is recommended that the **PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF STOPPING, WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING AND ON-STREET PARKING TAUNTON DEANE ORDER 2012 (AMENDMENT NO. 22) ORDER 2019** be approved to ensure the unobstructed thoroughfare of buses through the Bus Gate (Collett Road, Lydeard) and to address safety concerns caused by obstructive parking in Avon Close and Gaunton Close (Comeytrowe)

3.0 Proposed Traffic Regulation Orders

- 3.1 The Traffic Regulation Order (shown in Appendix 1) was advertised in the Somerset County Gazette on the 31st January 2019. As part of this process, all of the statutory consultees, local County and District Councillors and the Town Council were consulted.
- 3.2 Following the statutory advertising of the Traffic Regulation Order Amendment, five letters objecting to the proposal were received during the 21 day statutory advertising period for Collett Road, one letter objecting to the proposal was received for Avon Close and one letter objecting to the proposal for Gaunton Close was received. SCC have sent responses to these objectors explaining our position, but they still remain. These letters along with the responses are available for inspection at the Authors Department
- 3.3 Objection reasons include:

Collett Road (5 objections)

- Unaware of any 'potential' parking restrictions of this nature. Searches by Solicitor did not draw attention to this proposal.
- Current parking on one side of the road works well.
- Parking displacement to other areas of the estate and on the roundabout, Great Western Way.
- Parking availability in the road is currently a struggle.
- Householder not comfortable parking their car out of sight due to increased crime rate.
- The proposed no waiting restrictions are excessive as the Bus will only be using that Bus Gate once or twice a day.
- Owners will park their cars on the pavements due to the bend and drop in the road once you enter the Longmead Estate.

Other reasons for objections referred to the physical Bus Gate. These

objections cannot therefore be considered as part of the Order making process

Objection reasons include:

- Noise, Air and litter pollution.
- A request to reduce the widths of the very wide pavements / grass verges outside of the houses on both sides of the road to increase carriageway width for two-way traffic.
- Residents moved here for a clean, safe and quiet place to raise a family. The proposal goes against all of these very reasons for settlement.

The implementation of the Bus Gate was secured in the Section106 Agreement. When residents purchased their properties, this should have been declared through solicitor checks.

Response: Acknowledgments were sent to the objectors informing them that the proposals for the parking restrictions in Collett Road have been put forward to address parking issues which will affect bus movements when the Bus Gate opens. This acknowledgment also advised them that their feedback will be given consideration.

Collett Road is hazardous when trying to gain access/egress to the wider development. Parked cars along Collett Road will impede bus movements. There will be 41 bus movements through the Bus Gate every day Monday to Saturday. This figure excludes local buses who will also be permitted to use the Bus Gate.

Please see Appendix 3 - Bus timetable for the number 25 bus.

Avon Close (one objection)

- Objection to the proposed single yellow lines which run in front of numbers 20, 22 and 24 Avon Close. Objector has a short driveway with only room for one vehicle, so any visitors will be unable to park outside the property from 9am to 3.30pm Monday to Saturday. All other properties in the Close will not be penalised in this manner.

Response: An Acknowledgment was sent to the objector informing them that the proposals for the parking restrictions in Avon Close have been put forward by Councillor Wedderkopp to address safety concerns and obstructive parking in Avon Close near the turning head where the objector resides. This proposal will mean that the Objector and any visitors will have parking displacement by a distance of 8 metres during the time the restriction applies. This proposal received 9 letters of support. This acknowledgment also advised that their feedback will be given consideration.

Gaunton Close (one objection)

- Misinterpretation of proposal; first letter of objection was to 'No Waiting At Any Time' restrictions. Second letter mentions commuter parking but suggests that drivers have to take more care when passing the parked cars on this blind bend. There is concern that this proposal will take away hospital parking and commuters may park in the private parking bays at the end of Gaunton Close.

Response: An Acknowledgment was sent to the objector informing them that the proposals for the parking restrictions in Gaunton Close have been put forward by Councillor Wedderkopp to address safety concerns in Gaunton Close.

Commuter parking is prevalent Monday to Friday on the northern side of the road from the junction with College. Parking continues the entire length of the bend to property number 11. The carriageway on the opposite side of the bend has a reduced width which accommodates only one vehicle when cars are parked. The impact of cars parked on northern side of Gaunton Close means that cars travelling on the reduced width have to reverse to allow passing. Dangerous manoeuvres have been reported.

The response clarified that the proposal is for No Waiting Mon - Fri 9am – 3.30pm. This proposal received 3 letters of support. This acknowledgment also advised them that their feedback will be given consideration.

4.0 Resolution of Objections

4.1 For the reasons above it is recommended to:-

Collett Road, Norton Fitzwarren ; - **approve as advertised.**

Avon Close, Comeytrowe ; - **approve as advertised.**

Gaunton Close, Comeytrowe; - **approve as advertised.**

Approval for Construction:

The objections received during the consultation period have been given due consideration and I hereby confirm that the scheme **PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF STOPPING, WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING AND ON-STREET PARKING TAUNTON DEANE ORDER 2012 (AMENDMENT NO. 22) ORDER 2019** be approved.

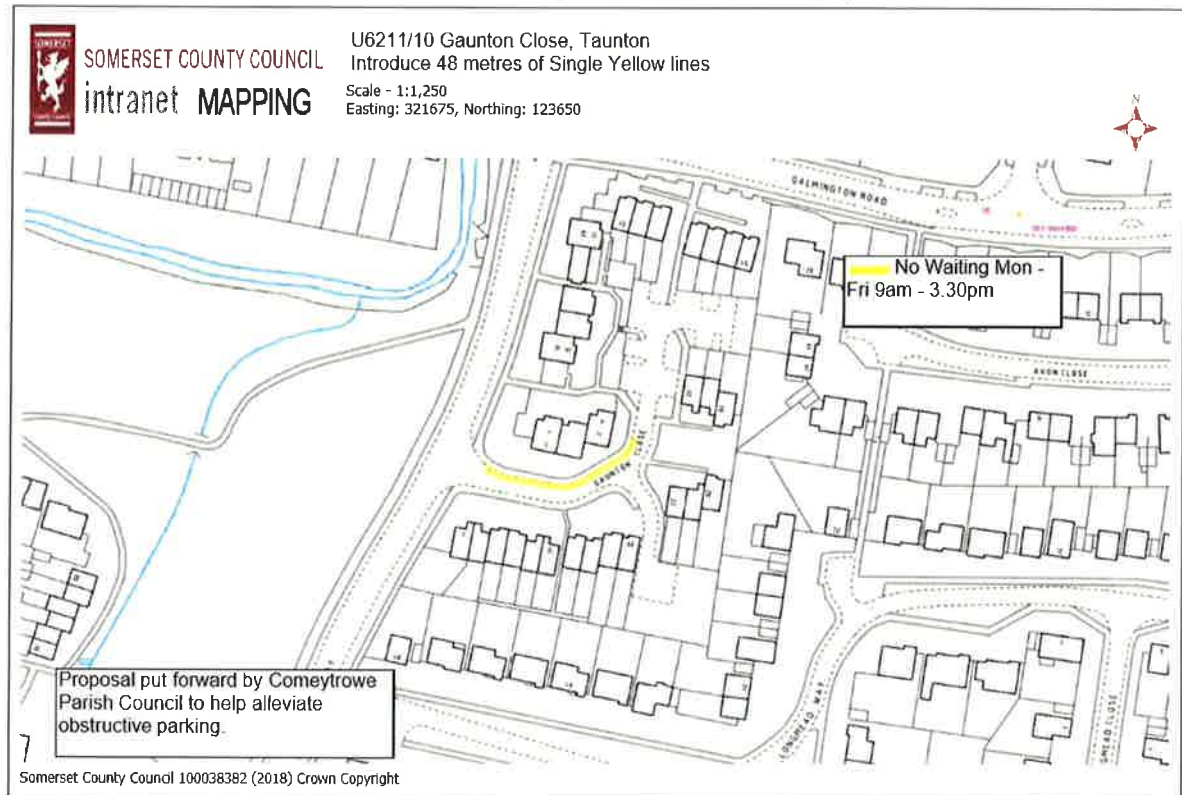
