

Somerset County Council
(Various Roads, District of Mendip)
(Temporary Traffic Restrictions) Order 2019
(Glastonbury Festival)

The County of Somerset in exercise of their powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on 25th April 2019 and will continue in force until Sunday 17th November 2019.
2. This Order may be cited as "Somerset County Council (Various Roads, District of Mendip) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions) Order 2019 (Glastonbury Festival)".
3. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
4. Upon coming into effect, any earlier enactment, having established a restriction on the lengths specified in the Schedules to this Order, are hereby temporarily revoked.
5. The following restrictions and prohibitions are made:
 - Schedule 1 - Temporary One-Way Traffic
 - Schedule 2 - Temporary Prohibition of Driving
 - Schedule 3 - Temporary Prohibition of Waiting, Stopping or Parking
 - Schedule 4 - Temporary permission for vehicles to pass in either direction
 - Schedule 5 - Temporary suspension of 7.5 tonne weight limit
 - Schedule 6 - Temporary Speed Limits
 - Schedule 7 – Temporary suspension of right turns
 - Schedule 8 – Temporary closure of Footpaths, Bridleways and Restricted Byways
6. Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall apply;
 - a. to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
 - b. to any vehicle being used for Police Service, Fire and Rescue Service or Ambulance Service purposes; or
 - c. vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations;

7. Nothing contained in this order shall be deemed to prohibit all traffic from using the highways listed in the schedules to this Order if such use is necessary;
- a. to any vehicle displaying a valid exemption permit or pass issued by Avon and Somerset Constabulary, Glastonbury Festival Events Limited or Somerset County Council;
 - b. to a vehicle that is being used to check, maintain or replace any sign, barrier or cone that has been placed in accordance with the Glastonbury Festival 2019 Traffic Management Plan;
 - c. to enable a vehicle including that of a Statutory Undertaker to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, laying erection, alteration or repair in or near the road of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of Gas, Water or electricity or a telegraphic line as defined in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984 as amended;
 - d. for the purpose of loading and unloading to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads specified in this Order; or
 - e. for the purpose of agriculture in connection with land adjoining or lying near to the length of said road or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land.

Schedule 1 – Temporary One-Way Traffic

To Temporarily Prohibit the driving of any vehicle in the following lengths of road (as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016):

Pylle Lane from the junction of Pylle Road to a point 70 metres from the junction with the A37, other than in a westerly direction, from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 until between 0800 and 1600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019.

Pylle Lane from the junction of Pylle Road to a point 70 metres from the junction with the A37, other than in an easterly direction, from between 0800 and 1600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 2100 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Pylle Road from Windinglake Farm to the junction with Pylle Lane, other than in a northerly direction, from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 until between 0800 and 1600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019.

Pylle Road from Windinglake Farm to the junction with Pylle Lane, other than in a southerly direction, from between 0800 and 1600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 2100 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Pylle Road from the junction with Copse Lane for a distance of 20 metres westwards, other than in an easterly direction, from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 until 800 hours on Tuesday the 2nd of July 2019

Stickleball Lane from its junction with the A361 to the junction with Castle Lane, other than in a northerly direction, from between 0800 and 1600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 2100 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Stickleball Lane from its junction with the A361 to the junction with Castle Lane, other than in a southerly direction, from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until between 0800 and 1600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019.

Copse Lane from the junction with Pylle Road to the junction of Neat Lane, other than in a northerly direction, from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 until 2100 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Neat Lane from the junction with Copse Lane to the junction with the A361, other than in a northerly direction, from between 0800 and 1400 on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 2100 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

B3136, Lambert's Hill, from the dismantled railway line bridge south to the A361 at Springfield Cross, other than in a northerly direction, from 0600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Ridge Lane from the junction with the B3136 to the junction with Cannards Grave Road, other than in an easterly direction from 0600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Lower Westholme Road from the junction with Chessell Lane to the junction with Perridge Hill, other than in a southerly direction, from 0900 hours on Wednesday the 26th of June 2019 until 2100 hours on Wednesday the 26th of June 2019.

Chessell Lane from the junction with Stocks Lane to the junction with Lower Westholme Road, other than in a southerly direction, from 0900 hours on Wednesday the 26th of June 2019 until 2100 hours on Wednesday the 26th of June 2019.

Stocks Lane from the junction with Middles Lane to the junction with Chessell Lane, other than in an easterly direction, from 0900 hours on Wednesday the 26th of June 2019 until 2100 hours on Wednesday the 26th of June 2019.

Middles Lane from the junction with Launcherley Road to the junction with Stocks Lane, other than in a southerly direction, from 0900 hours on Wednesday the 26th of June 2019 until 2100 hours on Wednesday the 26th of June 2019.

Launcherley Road from the junction with Woodford Road to the junction with Middles Lane, other than in an easterly direction, from 0900 hours on Wednesday the 26th of June 2019 until 2100 hours on Wednesday the 26th of June 2019.

Lower Westholme Road from the junction with Tanyard Lane to the junction with The A361, other than in a Northerly direction, from 0600 hours on Wednesday the 26th of June 2019 until 2100 hours on Thursday the 27th of June 2019.

Lower Westholme Road from the junction with Chessell Lane to the junction with Perridge Hill, other than in a northerly direction, from 2200 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 1730 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Chessell Lane from the junction with Stocks Lane to the junction with Lower Westholme Road, other than in a northerly direction, from 2200 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 1730 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Stocks Lane from the junction with Middles Lane to the junction with Chessell Lane, other than in a westerly direction, from 2200 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 1730 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Middles Lane from the junction with Launcherley Road to the junction with Stocks Lane, other than in a northerly direction, from 2200 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 1730 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Launcherley Road from the junction with Woodford Road to the junction with Middles Lane, other than in an easterly direction, from 2200 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 1730 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Stickleball Lane from the junction with Down Lane to the junction with Castle Lane, other than in a southerly direction, from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until between 0800 and 1600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019.

Down Lane from the junction with Castle Lane to the junction with Stickleball Lane, other than in a westerly direction, from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until between 0800 and 1600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019.

Castle Lane from the junction with Stickleball Lane to the junction with Down Lane, other than in a northerly direction, from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until between 0800 and 1600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019.

Stickleball Lane from the junction with Castle Lane to the junction with Down Lane, other than in a northerly direction, from between 0800 and 1600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Down Lane from the junction with Stickleball Lane to the junction with Castle Lane,

other than in an easterly direction, from between 0800 and 1600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Castle Lane from the junction with Down Lane to the junction with Stickleball Lane, other than in a southerly direction, from between 0800 and 1600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Cockmill Lane from Grid Ref 51:08:59 North 2:34:35 West (the junction with Orchard Gate) to Grid ref 51:09:24 North 2:34:29 West (the junction with Ash Tree Gap), other than in a Northerly direction, from between 0600 hours on Sunday the 23rd of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Schedule 2 – Temporary Prohibition of Driving

To Temporarily Prohibit the driving of any vehicle on the following lengths of road (as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). Access will be permitted for residents' vehicles and service vehicles displaying a valid pass or exemption permit issued by Avon and Somerset Constabulary, Glastonbury Festival Events Limited or Somerset County Council as appropriate:

- 1a Neat Lane from its junction with the A361 for a distance of 20 metres southwards from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.
- 1b Neat Lane at the junction with the A361, no entry to any traffic, when signs in place, from Sunday 23rd June to Monday 1st July when signs in place
- 1c Neat Lane from the junction with Copse Lane to the junction with the A361, other than in a northerly direction, from between 0800 and 1400 on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 2100 hours on Tuesday the 2nd of July 2019.
- 1d A361 at the junction with the B3136 to be closed eastbound to all traffic except for local access, public service vehicles and coaches, for the full width of the junction, from 0600 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019
- 1e Bowermead Lane at the junction with the A361 closure for 20 metres south bound from 0800 Tuesday 24th June to 18:00 Monday 1st July when signs in place.
- 2a Platterwell Lane for a distance of 100 metres westwards from its junction with the A37, from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 to 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.
- 2b A361 at the junction with the A37 to be closed westbound to all traffic except for local access, public service vehicles and coaches from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.
- 3 Hedge Lane from its junction with the A37 for a distance of 20 metres westwards from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

- 4 Pylle Lane from its junction with the A37 for a distance of 20 metres westwards from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 until 2100 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.
- 5a Middleway Road in Little Pennard at its junction with Pylle Hill for a distance of 20 metres westwards from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st July 2019.
- 5b Pylle Hill for a distance of 20 metres northwards from its junction at the southern end with an unclassified, unnamed road (Grid Ref: 360701, 137651) from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st July 2019.
- 6 The unclassified road (Grid Ref: 361210, 137273), running from the A37 to East Pennard, for a distance of 20 metres westwards from its junction with the A37 from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.
- 7a The unnamed, unclassified road (Grid Ref: 359799, 136629) running north from Orchard Lea Cottages for a distance of 20 metres north from the junction at its southern end from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 to 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

To Temporarily Prohibit vehicles from waiting, stopping or parking at any time on the following lengths of roads and lay-bys (unless the vehicle is displaying a valid exemption permit issued by Avon and Somerset Constabulary, Glastonbury Festival Events Limited or Somerset County Council) from 0001 hours to 2359 hours on Wednesday the 26th of June 2019 and from 1200 hours on Sunday the 30th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019 (as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016):

Lower Westholme Road from its junction with Perridge Hill to its junction with Chessell Lane.

Chessell Lane from its junction with Lower Westholme Road to its junction with Stocks Lane.

Stocks Lane from its junction with Chessell Lane to its junction with Middles Lane.

Middles Lane from Barrow Lane to its junction with Launcherley Road.

Launcherley Road from its junction with Middles Lane to its junction with Woodford Road.

Woodford Road from Launcherley Road to its junction with the A39.

Southtown Road for its entire length.

A361 Fishers Hill and Bere Lane for their entire lengths.

A37 from its junction with the A361 (Charlton Crossroads) south to the Whitstone roundabout on the southbound carriageway (East).

To Temporarily Prohibit vehicles from waiting, stopping or parking at any time on the following lengths of roads and lay-bys (unless the vehicle is displaying a valid exemption permit issued by Avon and Somerset Constabulary, Glastonbury Festival Events Limited or Somerset County Council) from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019 (as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016) on the following roads:

A361 from its junction with the A37 at Beardly Batch, through Pilton Village and West Pennard, to Breach Farm to include all lay-bys.

B3136, from its junction with the A361 to a point approximately 300 metres north of its junction with Ridge Lane.

The Class III roads, Neat Lane and Copse Lane, from their junction with the A361 south to Pylle Road.

Cockmill Lane from Pylle Road southwards to Pennard House at East Pennard.

From the Crown Hill crossroads in Pilton, the Class III roads, Shop Lane, Cumhill, Bread Street, Lower Street, Mount Pleasant, and Pylle Road for their entire lengths and Pylle Hill southwards to Little Pennard.

Parsons Batch from its junction with the A361 to its junction with Shop Lane.

Lower Westholme Road from the loop road at Steanbow; on the north side of the A361, to a point 40 metres north of the access road to Lower Westholme Farm.

Higher Westholme Road from its junction with the A361 to a point 100 metres west of Westholme House.

A37 from its junction with the A371 at the Whitstone roundabout southwards to the layby south of the Wraxall Crossroads, including Pyehill Landing.

The unclassified road, from its junction with the A37 near Writh Farm southwards to its junction with the unclassified road leading to Ditcheat, south of Vale View, and returning to the A37 at Pyehill Landing.

Easton Lane from its junction with the A37 to its junction with the A371.

The Class III road (including Hembridge Road, Parbrook Lane, West Bradley Lane, Scotts Lane, Breach Lane and Newtown), from its junction with the A37 at Wraxall Crossroads to its junction with the A361 at West Pennard.

Little Pennard Lane from its junction with the A37 to its junction with Church Lane, East Pennard.

Totterdown Lane, Pilton from the Crownhill Crossroads to Burford Cross.

Bowermead Lane, Pilton from Burford Cross to its junction with the A361 (Whitstone Hill).

Bradley Way for its entire length.

Middleway Road, East Pennard from Cockmill Lane to Boxbush Hill.

Ridge Lane from Lambert's Hill to Cannards Grave Road.

Stoodly Lane from Stoodly Bridge to Burford Cross.

Sawpits Lane for its entire length from the A361 to Sticklinch Road.

Sticklinch Road for its entire length between Castle Lane and Moggs Hole.

Moggs Hole for its entire length from Sticklinch Road and Castle Lane.

Castle Lane for its entire length from Sticklinch Road to Windmill Lane.

Windmill Lane for its entire length from Southtown Lane to Down Lane.

Down Lane for its entire length.

Southtown Lane, West Pennard for its entire length.

Church Lane, West Pennard for its entire length.

Kennel Lane, East Pennard for its entire length.

Church Lane, East Pennard for its entire length from Middleway Road to Hembridge Road.

Lay-by/link road on the northern side of the A361 to the west of the junction with Sawpits Lane.

A361 Lay-by east of Springfield Cross to the south side of the road.

Pylle Hill from Pylle Road to Little Pennard Lane.

Lower Road, Pilton from the junction with Copse Lane to the junction with Pylle Road.

Perridge Hill from the junction with Higher Westholme Road to Lower Westholme Road.

A371 from the junction with the B3153 north for a distance of 550 metres to the speed limit signs showing the change from 30mph to the national speed limit.

To Temporarily Prohibit vehicles from waiting, stopping or parking at any time on the following lengths of roads and lay-bys (unless the vehicle is displaying a valid exemption permit issued by Avon and Somerset Constabulary, Glastonbury Festival Events Limited or Somerset County Council) from 09:00 Tuesday 25th June through to 18:00 Wednesday 26th June. (as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016):

A361, Bere Lane.

A361 Chilkwell Street from the junction with A361 Bere Lane to the junction with Well House Lane.

Schedule 4 – Temporary Permission for Vehicles to pass in either direction

To Temporarily Suspend the One-Way Restriction (as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016):

Vehicles to pass in either direction along Shop Lane, Pilton except within a length of approximately 20 metres from its junction with the A361 at its northern end, from 0001 hours on Saturday the 22nd of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Schedule 5 – Temporary Suspension of 7.5 tonne Weight Limit

To Temporarily Suspend the 7.5 tonne weight limit (as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016):

In Shepton Mallet between Charlton Road/A37 junction and Commercial Road/A371 roundabout from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2359 hours on Tuesday the 2nd of July 2019.

Schedule 6 – Temporary Speed Limits (30 mph Speed Limit and 20 mph Speed Limit and 20 mph Zone)

To temporarily impose a 30 mph speed limit, 20 mph speed limit and 20 mph Zone on the following lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this order, no person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding the speed limit, (as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016):

To extend the existing speed restriction of 30 mph on the A361 from the west side of Pilton village to a point 300 metres west of the junction of Sawpits Lane from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

To extend the existing speed restriction of 30 mph on the A361 from the east side of Pilton Village to 300 metres east of the junction with the B3136 (Springfield Cross) from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

To restrict the speed of traffic on the A37 in both directions to 30 mph from a point approximately 50 metres north of Platterwell Lane to a point approximately 300 metres south of Writh Farm from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

To restrict the speed of traffic along Middles Lane in both directions to 30 mph from the junction with Launcherley Road to the junction with Stocks Lane from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

To restrict the speed of traffic along Launcherley Road in both directions to 30 mph from the junction with Middles Lane to the junction with the High Street from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

To restrict the speed of traffic along Stocks Lane in both directions to 30 mph from the junction with Pilton Hill to the junction with Middles Lane from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

To restrict the speed of traffic along Lower Westholme Lane in both directions to 30 mph from the junction with the A361 to the junction with Chessell Lane from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

To restrict the speed of traffic along Cockmill Lane in both directions to 20 mph from the junction with Pylle Road to the junction with Middleway Road from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

To restrict the speed of traffic along Copse Lane in both directions to 20 mph from the junction with Pylle Road to the junction with Neat Lane from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

To restrict the speed of traffic along Pylle Road in both directions to 20 mph from the junction with Cockmill Lane to the junction with Bread Street and Mount Pleasant from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

To restrict the speed of traffic along Parsons Batch, Cumhill and Bread Street and Mount Pleasant in both directions to 20 mph from the junction with the A361 to the junction with Pylle Road from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

To restrict the speed of traffic along St Marys in both directions to 20 mph from the junction with the A361 to the junction with Parsons Batch from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

To restrict the speed of traffic to 20 mph (20 mph Zone) within Pilton Village within the following road junctions - A361 with Parsons Batch, Barrow Stile (Shutwell Lane), Top Street, and Neat Lane; Neat Lane with John Burn Cottages, Top Street and Lower Street; Pylle Rd with Cockmill lane. Too include the following roads for the entire length; Parsons Batch, Shop Lane, Cumhill, Bread Street, Shutwell Lane, Barrow Stile, Weir Lane, Ford lane, Barrow Lane, Mount Pleasant, Lower Street, John Beales Hill, Top Street, John Burns Cottages, Copse Lane and the following road for the described length, Neat Lane between Copse Lane and John Burn Cottages and Pylle Road between Cockmill Lane and Bread St/Mount Pleasant junctions from 0001 hours on Tuesday the 25th of June 2019 until 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

Schedule 7 – Temporary Prohibition of Right Turns

To temporarily prohibit the right turn on the following lengths of road (as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016):

From the A361 onto the A37 at the junction of the A361 and A37 (Beardley Batch) from 0800 hours on Monday the 24th of June 2019 until 2359 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

From Ridge Lane eastbound onto the B3136 southbound at the junction of Ridge Lane and the B3136 Lambert's Hill from 0800 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019 until 2359 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

From West Compton Lane eastbound onto the B3136 southbound at the junction of West Compton Lane and the B3136 Lambert's Hill from 0800 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019 to 2359 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019.

From the B3136 Bath Rd onto the A37 Kilver St Hill southbound, from 0800 on Monday 1st of July 2019 to 2000 hours on Monday the 1st of July 2019

Schedule 8 – Temporary Closure of Footpaths, Bridleways and Restricted Byway

The following public highways shall be closed to all vehicular and pedestrian traffic from 0001 hours on Wednesday the 1st of May 2019 to 2359 hours on Friday the 19th of July 2019:

- a) Public Footpath SM16/33 across land being part of Worthy Farm, Pilton as designated on the Definitive Footpath Map for Somerset for its entire length.
- b) Public Footpaths SM16/28 and SM16/30 across land being part of Pilton Manor Vineyard on the east side of Park Hill, Pilton as designated on the Definitive Footpath Map for Somerset, for their entire length, including that part of Public Footpath SM16/28 heading in a south-westerly direction to Sticklinch.
- c) Public Footpath SM16/29 across land being part of Cumhill Farm, Cumhill Hill, Pilton as designated on the Definitive Footpath Map for Somerset for its entire length.

- f) Public Footpath SM9/05 between Public Footpath WS14/25 and Public Footpaths SM9/04 and SM9/21 as designated on the Definitive Footpath Map for Somerset for its entire length.
- g) Public Footpath WS14/25 between Stickleball Lane and Public Footpath SM9/05 as designated on the Definitive Footpath Map for Somerset.
- h) Public Footpath SM9/03 from Withial Hill to its junction with Public Footpath WS 14/25 as designated on the Definitive Footpath Map for Somerset for its entire length.
- i) Restricted Byway SM9/32 between Withial Hill and its junction with Public Footpath SM9/31 as designated on the Definitive Footpath Map for Somerset for its entire length.
- j) Public Footpath SM16/56 from Cum Hill Lane to its junction with Public Footpath SM16/30 as designated on the Definitive Footpath Map for Somerset for its entire length.

Access will be maintained for the passage of emergency services in Worthy Lane.

Statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order

- a) Because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road;
or
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
