RESTRICTION) ORDER 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), (2), (3), 4(2), 5 and Part IV on Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) hereinafter referred to as "the Act" and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act propose to make an Order, the effect of which is to introduce 2 metres (6 foot 6 inches) width restriction on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 below and to introduce a 7.5 tonne weight restriction on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 below.

The provisions of any other Order are hereby revoked as specified in Schedule 3 below.

A copy of the Order, the plan showing the extents of the restrictions and the Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at B Block Reception, County Hall, Taunton or online at www.somerset.gov.uk/TRO. If you are unable to access either please contact 0300 123 2224.

Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order may do so in writing, quoting Ref. No. KT18062019, specifying the grounds on which it is made, to Somerset County Council, Traffic Management, County Hall, Taunton, TA1 4DY and received no later than the 1st August 2019.

The names and addresses of anyone writing in may be made available for public inspection and will be included in a report that may be published on the Somerset County Council website, unless the individuals concerned state, in writing, their objection to their names and addresses being made so available or being included in the publication.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

- a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- b) for preventing damage to the road or to any building on or near the road, or
- c) for preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property.

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2, (3), 4(2), 5 and Part IV on Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) hereinafter referred to as "the Act" and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle (as defined in Section 136 of the Act), the width of which, inclusive of any load on the vehicle, exceeds 2 metres (6 foot 6 inches), to enter or proceed in the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order if the vehicle is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes.
3. The provisions of any other Order are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected on the length of road specified in the Schedules to this Order.
4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order, no person shall, other than with the permission of a Police officer in uniform, use, or cause or permit to be used, any heavy commercial goods vehicle in excess of 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight in such a way that it proceeds along the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
5. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall make it unlawful for any heavy commercial vehicle in excess of 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight to proceed along the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order if the vehicle is being used:-
 - i. for the purpose of loading and unloading to premises situated on or adjacent to the road specified in the Schedule to this Order;
 - ii. in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to the road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in the road, the maintenance, improvement, or reconstruction of the road, or the laying,

erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- iii. for the purposes of agriculture in connection with the land adjacent to that road or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon the land.
- iv. in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- v. in the service of the Police, Fire or Ambulance services in a case of emergency;
- vi. Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

6. This Order shall come into force on the xxxxxxxxxx 2019 and may be cited as "Somerset County Council (A366 Trowbridge Road, Frome (Parish of Norton St Philip) (2 Metres (6 Foot 6 Inches) Width Restriction and 7.5 Tonne Weight Restriction) Order 2019.
