(Temporary prohibition of vehicles) Order 2019

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along the roads specified in the schedule to this Order:-

This order will now be a night closures between the hours of 1900 to 0600 to enable Wessex Water to carry out repairs

The Order became effective on **23rd day of July 2019** and remains in force for eighteen months. While the closure is in operation an alternative route will be signed as detailed below.

This Order is required to facilitate highway works and is necessary for the safety of the workforce whilst carrying out their duties. The restriction shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.
