Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along:-

New Road, Chapel Allerton – From the Junction of Short Lane to the Junction with Front Street, a distance of 976 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **11th July 2019 for 8 days.**

New Road, Stone Allerton – Intersection of Stone Allerton Drove and front street to the junction of Short Lane, a distance of 330 metres. **The proposed date of the closure is 31st July 2019 for 3 days.**

This order will enable Gigaclear to carry out reinstatement works in this road.

The Order becomes effective on **13th December 2018** and will remain in force for eighteen months. While the closure is in operation an alternative route will be signed as detailed below.

This Order is required to facilitate highway works and is necessary for the safety of the workforce whilst carrying out their duties. The restriction shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.
