NOTICE is hereby given that Somerset County Council proposes to make the above Order in pursuance of the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which is to introduce a 30mph Speed Limit on the lengths of road as specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order.

The provisions of any other Orders are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this Order.

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into force on the xxth day of xxxxxxx 2019 and may be cited as "Somerset County Council (Various Roads, Barton St David) (Parish of Barton St David) (Revocation and 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2019".
2. The provisions of any other Orders are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
