

**The County of Somerset**

TAKE NOTICE that in pursuance of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended, the County Council of Somerset propose to make an Order to introduce a temporary No Entry on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this order.

This Order is required to facilitate highway works and is necessary for the safety of the workforce whilst carrying out their duties. The restriction shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.

This Order shall come into operation on 20<sup>th</sup> August 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to start on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> August 2019 and last for 3 weeks

The County Council of Somerset in exercise of their powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

The Order becomes effective on the 20<sup>th</sup> August 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works will commence on the 27<sup>th</sup> August 2019 for 3 weeks. The restriction will apply when indicated by traffic signs.

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter, proceed or wait along the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order
  
2. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to:
  - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
  - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
  - (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
  
3. This Order may be cited as Somerset County Council (A39, Broadway, Bridgwater) (Temporary No Entry on Friarn Street) Order 2019
