Notice is hereby given that Somerset County Council intends to make an order in pursuance of the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of motor vehicles on the lengths of road as detailed in the Schedule 1 of this Order. To introduce a temporary suspension of the No Entry, on the lengths of road detailed in Schedule 2 of this Order

The Order will be made to facilitate structural works and is in the interest of public safety.

The Order becomes effective on the 12th September 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works will commence on the 22nd September 2019 for 64 days. The restriction will apply when indicated by traffic signs.

Temporary Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

Eagle Lane, Frome	From its junction with King Street for a distance of 35 metres in a north westerly direction.
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Schedule 2
Temporary Suspension of No Entry Restriction

Eagle Lane, Frome	From its junction with B3090 Bath Street to allow access for residents

Somerset County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order.

The Order becomes effective on the 12th September 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works will commence on the 22nd September 2019 for 64 days. The restriction will apply when indicated by traffic signs.

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter, proceed or wait along the lengths of road specified in the schedule to this Order.

2. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to:
 - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform:
 - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
 - (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

3. The no entry restriction from B3090 Bath Street is temporarily revoked on the length of road specified in schedule 2 to this Order.

This Order may be cited as the Somerset County Council (Eagle Lane) (Parish of Frome) Mendip (Temporary Prohibition of Motor Vehicles and Suspension of No Entry Restriction) Order 2019

Schedule 1
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Statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order

- a) Because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road; or
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
