

**SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

Notice is hereby given that Somerset County Council proposes to make the above order in pursuance of the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a One Way and No Entry on Furge Lane, Henstridge as specified in the Schedules below.

An exemption will be provided within the order for statutory service vehicles and emergency service vehicles.

A copy of the draft Order, the map showing the length of road affected and the Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at Somerset Highways, B Block Reception, County Hall, Taunton and online at [www.somerset.gov.uk/TRO](http://www.somerset.gov.uk/TRO).

The names and addresses of anyone writing in may be made available for public inspection and will be included in a report that may be published on the Somerset County Council website, unless the individuals concerned state, in writing, their objection to their names and addresses being made so available or being included in the publication.

Somerset County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into force on the xx day of xxxxx 2019 and maybe cited as "Somerset County Council, Furge Lane Henstridge, (Parish of Henstridge) (Revocation, One Way and No Entry Order) 2019."
2. Save as in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a PCSO cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along Furge Lane from its junction with High Street in an easterly direction as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
3. Save as in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a PCSO cause or permit any vehicle to enter Furge Lane as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
4. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road referred to in the Article if the vehicle is being used for:
  - a) For Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes
  - b) In connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths or road of any sewer, or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any apparatus as defined in Paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunication Code contained in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act, 1984
  - c) The Vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in the service of a local authority, the Environment
