I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:

Adding a Restricted Byway known as Higher Ropes Drove in Catcott and Head Drove in Shapwick which runs from ST 3996 4144 to ST 4137 4089.

The application route, known as Higher Ropes Drove and Head Drove, runs from the northern end of West Drove in Catcott, a county road, eastwards along Higher Ropes Drove and Head Drove to the junction with Kent Drove in Shapwick. Kent Drove is the subject of another DMMO application.
