

**Somerset County Council**

**Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after communicating with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:

1. This Order will come into operation on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of September 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
2. Except as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person will cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait along the lengths of road specified in schedules to this Order
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order will apply to:
  - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
  - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
  - (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

This Order may be cited as Somerset County Council, Parishes of Badgworth, Chapel Allerton, Compton Bishop, Lympsham and Weare. Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

**Schedule**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

**Kennel Lane,  
Compton Bishop**

From its junction with Webbington Road for its entire length. The proposed date of the closure is **16<sup>th</sup> September 2019 for 5 days.**

**South View Farm  
Lane, Bagworth**

From its junction with the A38 Bristol Road for its entire length. The proposed date of the closure is **24<sup>th</sup> September 2019 for 7 days.**

**Purving Road,  
Lympsham**

From its junction with Eastertown for a distance of 120 metres in a southerly direction. The proposed date of the closure is **25<sup>th</sup> September 2019 for 6 days.**

**Notting Hill Way  
Weare**

From its junction with Badgworth Lane to a point 70 metres north of its junction with Sparrow Hill Way for a distance of 1130 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **26<sup>th</sup> October for 5 working days.**

**Weare Road,  
Chapel Allerton**

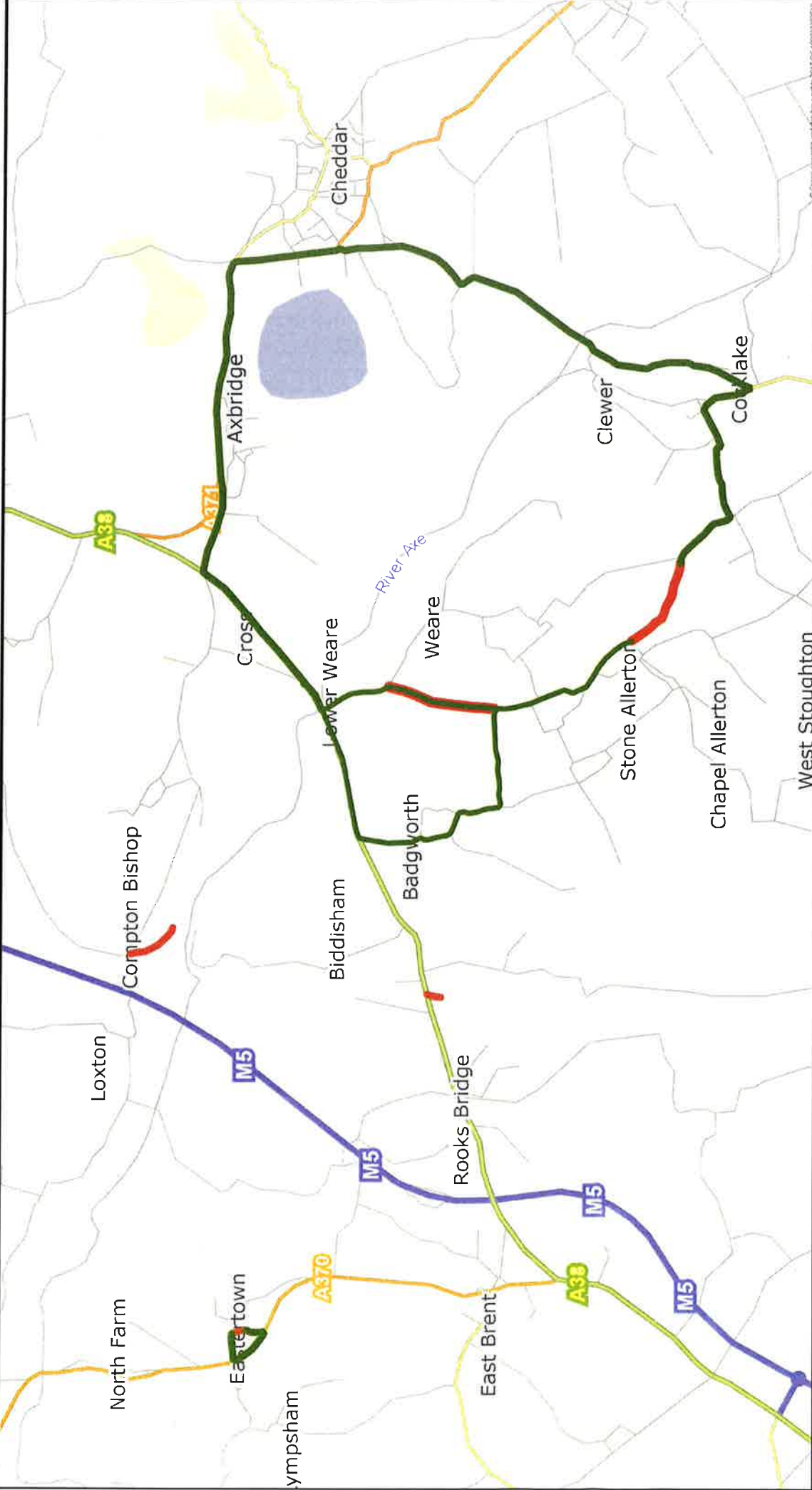
From its junction with Rawlings Lane to its junction with Quab Lane a distance of 990 metres. The proposed date of the of the closure is **16<sup>th</sup> May for 6 days**

**Statement of reasons for making the Order**

- a) Because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road;  
or
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
