Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

Somerset County Council, in exercise of its powers under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, has issued a Notice, the effect of which is to introduce a temporary Prohibition of vehicles restriction in the laybys on length of road listed in the Schedule to this Notice.

This Notice will come into operation on the 26th September 2019 and will remain in force for a maximum of 21 days. The nature of the work is reinforcing the verges along the C1182 Hinkley Point Road. If the works cannot be completed during that period, the Council may issue a further 21-day Notice under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or make a temporary Order under Section 14(1) of that Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for a further period. The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

Nothing in the Notice shall apply to any vehicle or plant being used in connection with the works being carried out.

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

C1182 Hinkley Point Road, Otterhampton (Eastbound)	Layby at the junction with Knaplock Lane.
C1182 Hinkley Point Road, Stockland Bristol (Eastbound)	Layby off Hinkley Point Road
C1182 Hinkley Point Road, Stogursey (Eastbound)	Layby 290 metres north west of Cock Lane
C1182 Hinkley Point Road, Stogursey (Westbound)	Layby 150 metres east of the junction with Shurston Road

Statement of reasons for making the Order

- a) because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road; or
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
