I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:

Upgrading part of footpath T 30/17 from ST 1667 3350 to ST 1663 3343 to a Restricted Byway and adding a Restricted Byway from ST 1663 3343 to ST 1638 3280 in the parish of West Bagborough.

The application route runs from the county road in West Bagborough, south-south-westwards for a short distance along footpath T 30/17, and continues along a track, through a bend track further south, and thence onwards to the county road north of Shopnoller.
