Notice is hereby given that Somerset County Council intends to make an Order in pursuance of Section 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following Order the effect of which will be to introduce temporary traffic restrictions on various roads in Prestleigh and Evercreech as specified in the Schedules to this Order.

The Order will be made to facilitate the Westfest at the Bath and West Showground and is in the interest of public safety. The restrictions shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The Order shall come into operation at 0600 hours on Saturday the 26th October 2019 and will remain in force until 1400 hours on Sunday the 27th October 2019.

Somerset County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

1. The Order shall come into operation at 0600 hours on Saturday the 26th October 2019 and will remain in force until 1400 hours on Sunday the 27th October 2019.
2. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop or wait in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order between the hours of 0800 Saturday 26th October 2019 – 0800 on Sunday 27th October 2019. The restriction shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.
3. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person shall drive any motor vehicle in a southbound direction only on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order. The restriction shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.
4. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 mph on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this order. The restriction shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.
5. The provisions of any other Order are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this order.
6. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to:
 - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
 - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
 - (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations
7. This Order may be cited as Somerset County Council (A371 Bath and West Showground, in the Parishes of Prestleigh and Evercreech) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions) (Special Events) Order 2019 (Westfest Bath and West Showground).
