DEFINITIVE FOOTPATH MAP

Arising from correspondence my Parish Council has had with Yeovil District Council regarding a certain Right of Way in the village, it has now been established that there are several foot- or bridle-paths through which the Public have Right of Way which do not appear on the official Definitive Footpaths Map.
