Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following Order: -

This Order will come into operation on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of October 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The effect of which will be to introduce a Temporary 20mph Speed Limit on the roads specified in the schedule 1 to this Order, to introduce a Temporary 30mph Speed Limit on the roads specified in the schedule 2 to this Order and to introduce a Temporary Prohibition of vehicles on the roads specified in the schedule 3 to this Order

The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

**Schedule 1**  
**Temporary 20mph Speed Limit**

Hillside,  
Puriton

From its junction with Cypress Drive to its junction with A39 Puriton Hill.

Woolavington Road  
Puriton

From a point 60 metres east of its junction with Puriton Park to a point 240 metres west of its junction with East Approach Road

**Schedule 2**  
**Temporary 30mph Speed Limit**

A39 Glastonbury Road  
and Puriton Hill,  
Puriton

From its junction with A39 Dunball Interchange Roundabout in a South-Easterly direction for a distance of 1300 metres.

**Schedule 3**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

Puriton Hill,  
Puriton

From its junction with A39 Glastonbury Road for a distance of 150 metres in north westerly direction

**Statement of reasons for making the Order**

- a) Because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road; or
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.

1. This Order will come into operation on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of October 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter, proceed or wait along the lengths of road specified in schedule 3 to this Order.
5. Nothing in Articles 2, 3 and 4 of this Order will apply to:
  - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
  - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
  - (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
