


**Somerset County Council

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after communicating with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:

1. This Order will come into operation on the 4th day of April 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
2. Except as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person will cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait along the lengths of road specified in schedules to this Order
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order will apply to:
 - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
 - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
 - (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

This Order may be cited as Somerset County Council, District of South Somerset in the Parishes of Dinnington, Donyatt, Dowlish Wake Crewkerne, Lopen, Misterton, South Petherton & West Crewkerne Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

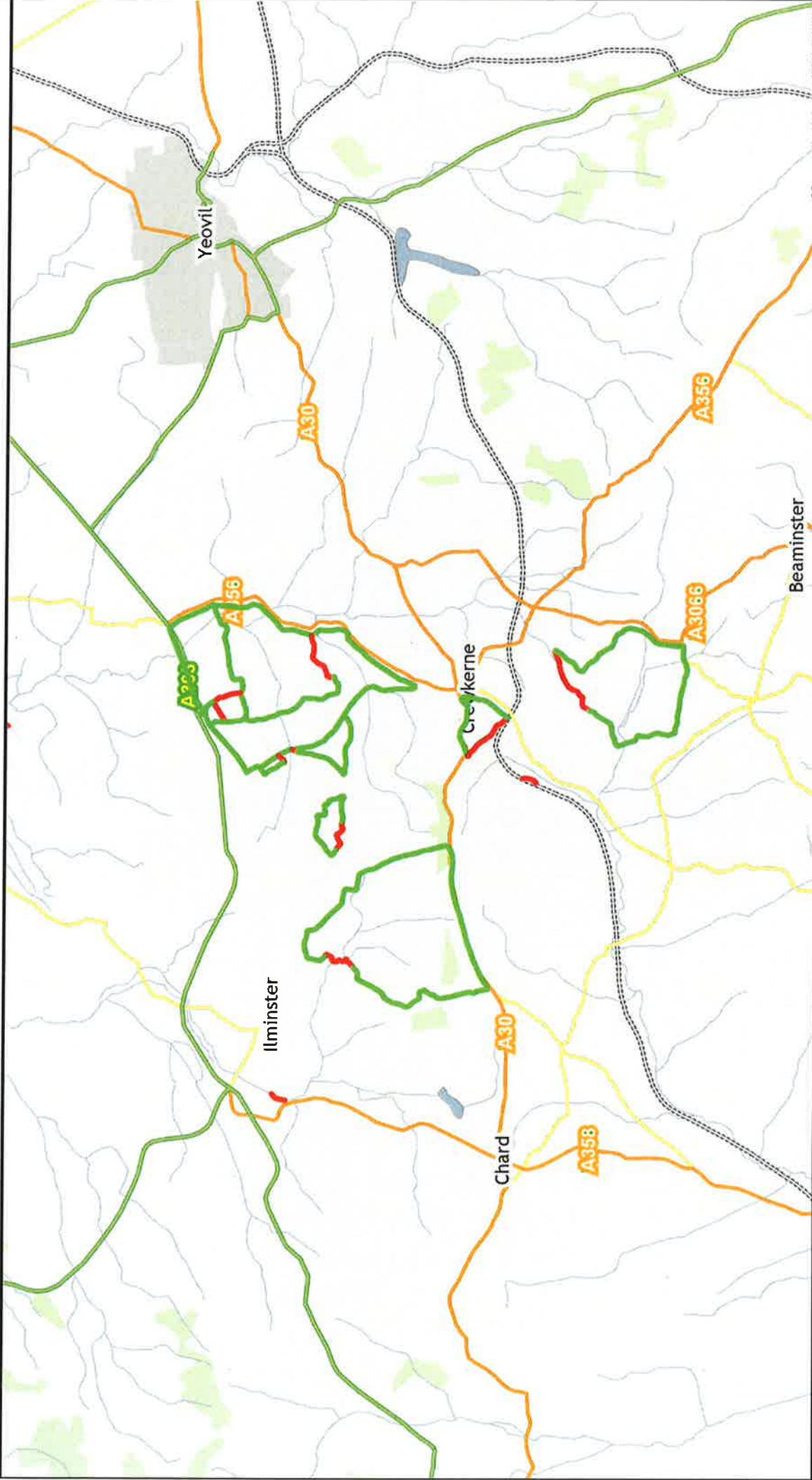

| Brimclose Road/Pit Hill/ Pit Road, Dinnington | From its junction with Church Hill to a point 570 metres west of its junction with New Road, a distance of 950 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 8th April 2019 for 6 days |
| Eggwood Hill, Merriot | From its junction with Merriot Road to its junction with Broadway, a distance of 1080 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 2nd May 2019 for 12 days. |
| Park Lane, Donyatt | For its entire length. The proposed date of the closure is 10th May 2019 for 11 days. |
| Apple Close, Dowlish Wake | For its entire length. The proposed date of the closure is 13th May 2019 for 5 days. |
| Lopen Road, Hinton St George | Junction off Merriott Road for a distance of 100 metres in a south westerly direction. The proposed date of the closure is 14th May 2019 for 2 days. |
| Main Street, Dowlish Wake | Entrance to Manor Farm to Junction with Main Street to Cudworth Road, a distance of 1100 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 15th May 2019 for 7 days. |
| Higher Street/ Boozer Pit, Merriott | Higher Street to Boozer Pit, a distance of 421 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 18th May 2019 for 7 days |
| Yeabridge Lane, South Petherton | From its junction with Fosse Way to its junction with South Harp, a distance of 740 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 31st May 2019 for 8 days. |
| Cathole Bridge Road, Crewkerne | From its junction with Chard Road, a distance of 1375 metres. The proposed dates of the closure are the 3rd June 2019 for 6 days and 10th June for 10 days. (Please note that this closure will be carried out in two phases) |
| Water Street/ Frog Street, Lopen | From its junction with Holloway Road to its junction with Water Lane, a distance of 217 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 6th June 2019 for 7 days. |
| Watery Lane, Hewish | For its entire length. The proposed date of the closure is 9th June 2019 for 3 days. |
| Fosse Way, South Petherton | From its junction with Over Stratton Road to Yeabridge Lane, a distance of 550 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 10th June 2019 for 5 days. |
| Seaborough Road, Henley | Junction with unnamed road to Junction with Knowle Lane, a distance of 1702 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 12th June 2019 for 6 days. |

Statement of reasons for making the Order

- a) Because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road;
or
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
