(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2020
(Snowdrop Valley event 2020 & 2021)


The County of Somerset in exercise of their powers under Section 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following order:

1. This Order will come into operation on the 17th day of January 2020 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
2. Except as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person will cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait along the lengths of road specified in schedules to this Order
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order will apply to:
 - i. Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
 - ii. Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
 - iii. Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations
 - iv. any vehicle being used for the purpose of maintenance of the road and operations; maintenance of street furniture and infrastructure; supply of gas, water or electricity; agriculture on any land adjacent;
 - v. Residents requiring access and egress.
 - vi. Any vehicles associated with the event.
4. This Order may be cited as Somerset County Council, Drapers Way and Steart Lane, Cutcombe (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2020 (Snowdrop Valley event 2020 & 2021).

- Drapers Way - From its junction with the B3224 (Dunkery Road) at Blagdon Cross to Cutcombe its junction with the A396 (Pitt Bridge). A total distance of approximately 3876 metres.
- Stear Lane - From its junction with the A396 (Cutcombe Hill) to its junction with Cutcombe Drapers Way. A total distance of approximately 340 metres.

Statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order

- a) because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road;
or
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
